Insight Network Logistics to Supply VinVision® System in Mexico for DaimlerChrysler

The system also provides a network alert map display that logistics managers use

to quickly spot potential problems in the supply chain that could delay vehicles. In addition to tracking shipments, the system provides productivity measures, inventory data and statistics, process deviation alerts, and up-to-the-minute network and supplier performance metrics.

“VinVision® has become an essential part of our daily logistics operations, because it provides the information we need, quickly and easily,” said Ed Sprock, Director, Logistics, DaimlerChrysler.

In mid 2003, DaimlerChrysler and INL rolled out VinVision® to over 4,100-plus U.S. and Canadian Chrysler Group dealers and 11 regional business centers. The system allows dealers to check up-to-the-minute location and ETA information of every inbound vehicle.
